ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUALS

What:

The Autism Society's program of assistance to individuals will provide up to \$250 in assistance per person per calendar to persons on the spectrum.

Assistance will be in the form of direct payment to vendors, service providers, or suppliers, not to the individual.

Who is Eligible

Any individual on the autism spectrum who lives in our service area is eligible.

Eligible Expenses (These are examples of eligible expenses. additional appropriate expenses will be considered)

For Children:

- speech therapy co-pays
- occupational therapy co-pays
- prescriptions co-pays
- counseling fees
- charges for therapeutic activities (e.g., Davenport Junior Theatre's "Spectrum Theatre," Challenger Little League)
- cost of sensory items, (e.g., weighted blankets, indoor swings)

For Adults:

- books or supplies needed for classes
- rent deposits
- prescription co-pays
- counseling co-pays

PROCESSING REQUESTS

- Requests for assistance must be submitted in writing
- An invoice for the cost incurred must accompany the request
- Checks will be issued to vendors, service providers, or suppliers, not to individuals
- Assistance is limited to \$250 per person per calendar year.
